These problems were resulting in lower profitability and customer satisfactions issues, and the objective was to develop a sustainable and measurable solution of improvement which could be maintained and scaled as the business continued to grow.

CHALLENGES

- Numerous systematic picking methodology, such as Case Pick, Each Pick, and Retail pick had to be evaluated.
- Transactions taking place across multiple systems – Produce Pro & Vocollect system.
- Multi-language workforce across all shifts

OUTCOME

Upon completion and adoption of the new processes, the client was able to utilize these strategic and executable tools to drive 24.5% reduction in Short-Credits compared to the same period from the previous year and maintained those gains continuously.
